The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Transportation Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for local roads in Blaine;
1.3 authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. ROAD PROJECTS; APPROPRIATION AND BOND SALE
1.6 AUTHORIZATION.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$170,000 is appropriated from the bond
1.8 proceeds fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Blaine for
1.9 reconstruction or maintenance of Davenport Street in Blaine. This amount represents the
1.10 National Sports Center share of costs for the project.

1.11 (b) \$42,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of
1.12 transportation for a grant to Anoka County for environmental assessment, preliminary
1.13 engineering, and design for reconstruction or maintenance of Anoka County Road 87,
1.14 known as 105th Avenue, in Blaine. This amount represents the city share of costs for
1.15 the project.

1.16 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.17 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.18 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$212,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.19 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.20 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.21 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
