1.7	(a) \$500,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from
1.8	the general fund to the commissioner of higher education for immediate transfer to Wallin
1.9	Education Partners to support programming focused on college admission and college
1.10	graduation for low-income students, including financial aid, advising, and career
1.11	development.
1.12	(b) This appropriation must be used by Wallin Education Partners only for programs
1.13	supporting students who are residents of Minnesota and attending colleges or universities
1.14	within Minnesota.
1.15	(c) By February 1 of each fiscal year that Wallin Education Partners receives an
1.16	appropriation, Wallin Education Partners must report to the chairs and ranking minority
1.17	members of the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction over higher education
