120A.42 CONDUCT OF SCHOOL ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS. 1.6

The governing body of any district A school board may contract with any of the 1.7

- exclusive representative of teachers of in the district for the to conduct of schools, and may 1.8
- conduct schools, school on either, or any, of the following holidays, provided that a clause 1.9
- to this effect is inserted in the teacher's contract if at least one hour of the school day is 1.10
- devoted to a patriotic observance of the day: Martin Luther King's birthday, Lincoln's and 1.11
- Washington's birthdays, Columbus Day, and Veterans' Day. On Martin Luther King's 1.12
- birthday, Washington's birthday, Lincoln's birthday, and Veterans' Day at least one hour of 1.13
- the school program must be devoted to a patriotic observance of the day. 1.14
- **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.15
