| 1.6 | Section 1. DAKOTA COUNTY; PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAILS. |
| 1.7 | Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,300,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund |
| 1.8 | to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to Dakota County for design and construction of |
| 1.9 | pedestrian safety-related improvements, including a grade-separated crossing of marked |
| 1.10 | Trunk Highway 55 at the intersection of County State-Aid Highway 28 and County State-Aid |
| 1.11 | Highway 63 in Dakota County. This appropriation includes money for the Mendota to |
| 1.12 | Lebanon Hills Greenway Crossing. |
| 1.13 | Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond |
