(a) April 2 of each year is designated Autism Awareness and Acceptance Day to

commemorate and celebrate the unique talents and innovations of those individuals with

autism in Minnesota while raising awareness about individuals with autism throughout the

(b) Each year the governor shall issue a proclamation honoring the observance and
