1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$51,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to complete the design of
1.10	and to construct, furnish, and equip a new James Ford Bell Natural History Museum
1.11	and Planetarium on the St. Paul campus. This appropriation is intended to cover the
1.12	entire project cost.
1.13	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
