1.6	Section 1. HISTORIC FORT SNELLING PRESERVATION AND
1.7	IMPROVEMENT.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Minnesota Historical Society for predesign and design of facilities to support
1.10	visitor services and history programs at Historic Fort Snelling.
1.11	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.12	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.13	bonds of the state in an amount up to \$4,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.14	the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.15	Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
