1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **EXONERATION AWARDS.**

1.6 \$108,684.65 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of management and budget for full payment of awards of damages under the Imprisonment
