1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to game and fish; allowing residents age 84 or over to take deer of  
 1.3 either sex; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97B.301, by adding a  
 1.4 subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97B.301, is amended by adding a  
 1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 9. Residents age 84 or over may take deer of either sex. A resident age 84  
 1.9 or over may take a deer of either sex. This subdivision does not authorize the taking of an  
 1.10 antlerless deer by another member of a party under subdivision 3.
