1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money and modifying an appropriation
1.3 for a grant to Pipestone County; amending Laws 2018, chapter 214, article 1,
1.4 section 21, subdivision 18.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2018, chapter 214, article 1, section 21, subdivision 18, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 18. Pipestone County - Dental Facility 500,000

1.9 For a grant to Pipestone County to predesign,
1.10 design, construct, furnish, and equip a dental
1.11 care facility in Pipestone County. The county
1.12 may enter into an agreement under Minnesota
1.13 Statutes, section 16A.695, for operation of the
1.14 dental clinic. This project is not subject to the
1.15 requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section
1.16 16B.325.

1.17 Sec. 2. PIPESTONE COUNTY; DENTAL FACILITY.

1.18 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.19 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Pipestone
1.20 County to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a dental care facility in Pipestone
1.21 County. This appropriation is in addition to the appropriation for the same purpose in Laws
1.22 2018, chapter 214, article 1, section 21, subdivision 18.

2.1 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
2.2 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
2.3 the state in an amount up to \$250,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
2.4 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
2.5 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

2.6 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
