1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. KOOCHICHING RENEWABLE ENERGY CLEAN AIR PROJECT.
1.7	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$12,000,000 is appropriated from the bond
1.8	proceeds fund to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to Koochiching County or
1.9	the Koochiching Development Agency to design, construct, and equip a plasma torch
1.10	gasification facility that converts municipal solid waste into energy and slag, reducing
1.11	the need to dispose of the waste in a landfill. This appropriation may be used for any or
1.12	all or any combination of the following:
1.13	(1) to upgrade an existing waste transfer station in Koochiching County to serve the
1.14	facility by performing site work, construction, or placement of equipment; or
1.15	(2) to prepare a site for or to construct and equip a portion of the plasma torch
1.16	gasification facility. This appropriation, or any portion of it, is available as matched,
1.17	dollar-for-dollar, with money from nonstate sources.
1.18	Subd. 2. <b>Bond sale.</b> To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

1.21	the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
