1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 62Q.75, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. **Claims adjustment timeline.** (a) Once a clean claim, as defined in section
1.7 62Q.75, subdivision 1, has been paid, the contract must provide a 12-month deadline on all
1.8 adjustments to and recoupments of the payment with the exception of ~~payments related to~~
1.9 ~~coordination of benefits, subrogation, duplicate claims, retroactive terminations,~~ and cases
1.10 of fraud and abuse.

1.11 (b) Paragraph (a) shall not apply to pharmacy contracts entered into between or on behalf
1.12 of health plan companies.
