1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a barrier against an invasive
1.3 carp species of fish on the Mississippi River; authorizing the sale and issuance of
1.4 state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; PROTECTING UPPER MISSISSIPPI RIVER FROM
1.7 INVASIVE CARP.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$16,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9 fund to the commissioner of natural resources to design and install a deterrent system at
1.10 Mississippi River Lock and Dam 5 to impede passage of invasive carp species described
1.11 in Minnesota Rules, part 6216.0250, subpart 3. The commissioner must complete the design
1.12 of the deterrent system by December 31, 2024, and must complete installation by July 1,
1.13 2026.

1.14 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.15 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.16 the state in an amount up to \$16,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.17 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.18 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.19 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
