.8	Subd. 2. Tribal education liaisons. For grants to Leech Lake-area school districts
.9	to hire tribal education liaisons to address truancy and other issues in an effort to close the
.10	achievement gap in Native American students served by these districts:
.11	<u>\$ 500,000 2017</u>
.12	Grants shall be awarded in equal amounts: \$100,000 each year is for Independent
.13	School District No. 115, Cass Lake-Bena; \$100,000 each year is for a partnership between
.14	Independent School Districts Nos. 317, Deer River, and 318, Grand Rapids; \$100,000 each
.15	year is for Independent School District No. 113, Walker-Hackensack-Akeley; \$100,000
