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1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. FACTUAL AND OBJECTIVE INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS;
1.6	CRITICAL RACE THEORY.
1.7	A school district must ensure instruction for students is factual, objective, and aligned
1.8	to the kindergarten through grade 12 curriculum standards. A school district or public school
1.9	may not require instruction relating to critical race theory in required curriculum. For
1.10	purposes of this section, "critical race theory" means a practice of examining the role of
1.11	race and racism in society, the social construction of race and institutionalized racism, and
1.12	how race intersects with identity, systems, and policies.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
