BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **TRAVERSE COUNTY COURTHOUSE.**
- 1.6

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$5,100,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.7

to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Traverse
- 1.8

County to demolish the existing county courthouse in Wheaton, and to predesign, design,
- 1.9

construct, furnish, and equip a courthouse on the same location. This appropriation is not
- 1.10

available until the commissioner of management and budget determines that at least \$587,000
- 1.11

has been committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
- 1.12

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.13

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.14

the state in an amount up to \$5,100,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.15

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.16

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
