Report. The commissioner of education must review current academic standards 1.10 under Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.021, and, with stakeholder input, assess the standards 1.11 for relevance and rigor. By January 1, 2022, the commissioner must submit a report to the 1.12 chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees having jurisdiction over 1.13 education policy summarizing the commissioner's findings and making a recommendation 1.14 on whether to modify the ten-year cycle for reviewing and revising standards. 1.15
