1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. CITY OF MOORHEAD; TAXES AUTHORIZED.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Sales and use tax authorization. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes,
1.7	section 297A.99, subdivision 1, or 477A.016, or any other law, ordinance, or city charter,
1.8	and if approved by the voters at a general election held no later than November 8, 2022, the
1.9	city of Moorhead may impose by ordinance a sales and use tax of one-half of one percent
1.10	for the purposes specified in subdivision 2. Except as otherwise provided in this section,
1.11	the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, section 297A.99, govern the imposition, administration,
1.12	collection, and enforcement of the tax authorized under this subdivision. The tax imposed
1.13	under this subdivision is in addition to any local sales and use tax imposed under any other
1.14	special law.
1.15	Subd. 2. Use of sales and use tax revenues. The revenues derived from the tax authorized
1.16	under subdivision 1 must be used by the city of Moorhead to pay the costs of collecting and
1.17	administering the tax and paying for the following projects in the city, including securing
1.18	and paying debt service on bonds issued to finance all or part of the following projects:
1.19	(1) \$25,000,000 plus associated bonding costs for a regional community and aquatics
1.20	center;
1.21	(2) \$25,300,000 plus associated bonding costs for a regional library and city hall complex:

(3) \$75,500,000 plus associated bonding costs for regional transportation improvements;

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	(4) \$1,000,000 plus associated bonding costs for construction and equipping of a regional

	(5) \$4,700,000 plus associated bonding costs for construction and renovation of regional

	Subd. 3. Bonding authority. (a) The city of Moorhead may issue bonds under Minnesota
S	tatutes, chapter 475, to finance all or a portion of the costs of the facilities authorized in
sı	abdivision 2 and approved by the voters as required under Minnesota Statutes, section
29	97A.99, subdivision 3, paragraph (a). The aggregate principal amount of bonds issued
uı	nder this subdivision may not exceed:
	(1) \$25,000,000 for the project listed in subdivision 2, clause (1), plus an amount to be
aj	oplied to the payment of the costs of issuing the bonds;
	(2) \$25,300,000 for the project listed in subdivision 2, clause (2), plus an amount to be
aj	oplied to the payment of the costs of issuing the bonds;
	(3) \$75,500,000 for the project listed in subdivision 2, clause (3), plus an amount to be
aį	oplied to the payment of the costs of issuing the bonds;
	(4) \$1,000,000 for the project listed in subdivision 2, clause (4), plus an amount to be
aj	oplied to the payment of the costs of issuing the bonds; and
	(5) \$4,700,000 for the project listed in subdivision 2, clause (5), plus an amount to be
aj	oplied to the payment of the costs of issuing the bonds.
Γ	he bonds may be paid from or secured by any funds available to the city of Moorhead,
in	cluding the tax authorized under subdivision 1. The issuance of bonds under this
sι	abdivision is not subject to Minnesota Statutes, sections 275.60 and 275.61.
	(b) The bonds are not included in computing any debt limitation applicable to the city
oi	f Moorhead, and any levy of taxes under Minnesota Statutes, section 475.61, to pay principal
aı	nd interest on the bonds is not subject to any levy limitation. A separate election to approve
	te bonds under Minnesota Statutes, section 475.58, is not required.
	Subd. 4. <b>Termination of taxes.</b> Subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 297A.99,
sı	ubdivision 12, the tax imposed under subdivision 1 expires at the earlier of (1) December
	1, 2048, or (2) when the city council determines that the amount received from the tax is
	afficient to pay for the project costs authorized under subdivision 2 for projects approved
	y the voters as required under Minnesota Statutes, section 297A.99, subdivision 3, paragraph
(a	), plus an amount sufficient to pay the costs related to issuance of any bonds authorized
uı	nder subdivision 3, including interest on the bonds. Except as otherwise provided in

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Mi	nnesota Statutes, section 297A.99, subdivision 3, paragraph (f), any funds remaining
<u>aft</u>	er payment of the allowed costs due to the timing of the termination of the tax under
Mi	nnesota Statutes, section 297A.99, subdivision 12, must be placed in the general fund of
the	city. The tax imposed under subdivision 1 may expire at an earlier time if the city so
de	ermines by ordinance.
