1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to energy conservation; providing an exception to heating restrictions
1.3 in commercial parking facilities; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section
1.4 216C.20, subdivision 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 216C.20, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Parking ramp.** No enclosed structure or portion of an enclosed structure
1.8 constructed after January 1, 1978, and used primarily as a commercial parking facility for
1.9 three or more motor vehicles shall be heated. Incidental heating resulting from building
1.10 exhaust air passing through a parking facility shall not be prohibited, provided that
1.11 substantially all useful heat has previously been removed from the air. This subdivision
1.12 does not prohibit a publicly owned parking facility from being heated if the public parking
1.13 is integrated within a facility that has both public and private uses.
