1.6	Section 1. OTTER TAIL COUNTY; PERHAM TO PELICAN RAPIDS
1.7	RECREATIONAL TRAIL.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,977,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9	to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to Otter Tail County to acquire
1.10	right-of-way, predesign, design, engineer, and construct the west segment of the Perham to
1.11	Pelican Rapids Recreational Trail, which goes from the city of Pelican Rapids south and
1.12	east for approximately 6.83 miles to the west boundary of Maplewood State Park. This
1.13	appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines
1.14	that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by
1.15	Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
1.16	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
