- Subd. 3. **Rulemaking.** The commissioner of health shall adopt rules <u>for establishing</u> licensure <u>requirements</u> and <u>enforcement of applicable laws and rules work standards</u> relating to indoor radon in dwellings and other buildings, with the exception of newly constructed Minnesota homes according to section 326B.106, subdivision 6. The commissioner shall coordinate, oversee, and implement all state functions in matters concerning the presence, effects, measurement, and mitigation of risks of radon in dwellings and other buildings.
- 1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
- 1.17 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2015 Supplement, section 144.4961, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:
