1.5	Section 1. DEVELOPMENT OF AN INCOME-SHARE AGREEMENT PILOT
1.6	PROGRAM PROPOSAL.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Development of a pilot program proposal. (a) For the purposes of
1.8	this section, "income-share agreement" means a method of financing higher education in
1.9	which a student signs a contract to pay to the state of Minnesota, or to the institution in
1.10	which the student is enrolled, a certain percentage of the student's annual adjusted gross
1.11	income for a specified number of years upon graduation from the institution.
1.12	(b) The commissioner of higher education must convene a working group to design
1.13	a proposal for a pilot program to pay for higher education costs for participating students
1.14	using income-share agreements. The working group must include the president of the
1.15	University of Minnesota, the chancellor of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities,
1.16	student representatives from both systems, and other interested stakeholders as determined
1.17	by the commissioner.
1.18	(c) The commissioner must submit a report to the legislature describing the pilot
1.19	program proposal no later than January 31, 2017. The report must describe any legislation
1.20	required for implementation of the pilot program, including an estimate of the funding
