Subd. 3. P i	ilot project. (a) For the duration of the pilot project, a medical cannabis
manufacturer	may:
(1) grow ca	annabis plants from seed or immature plant to mature plant;
(2) harvest	cannabis flower from a mature plant;
(3) package	e and label immature cannabis plants and seedlings, adult-use cannabis flower,
nd medical ca	annabis flower for sale to a Minnesota Tribal government, Tribal cannabis
ousiness, or Ti	ribal medical cannabis business;
(4) manufa	acture cannabis products;
(5) packag	e and label adult-use cannabis products and medical cannabinoid products
or sale to a M	linnesota Tribal government, Tribal cannabis business, or Tribal medical
cannabis busir	ness; and
(6) transpo	rt immature cannabis plants and seedlings, adult-use cannabis flower, medical
cannabis flower	er, adult-use cannabis products, and medical cannabinoid products to Tribally
egulated land	for delivery to a Minnesota Tribal government, Tribal cannabis business, or
ribal medical	cannabis business.
(b) A medi	cal cannabis manufacturer may only sell or deliver immature cannabis plants
and seedlings,	adult-use cannabis flower, medical cannabis flower, adult-use cannabis
oroducts, and a	medical cannabinoid products to a Tribal cannabis business or Tribal medical
annabis busir	ness after receiving explicit authorization to make the sale or delivery from
he Minnesota	Tribal government that licenses the business.
(c) Sale by	a Minnesota Tribal government, Tribal cannabis business, or Tribal medical
cannabis busir	ness of immature cannabis plants and seedlings, adult-use cannabis flower,
nedical canna	bis flower, adult-use cannabis products, and medical cannabinoid products
received from	a medical cannabis manufacturer is subject to the terms of any compact
negotiated pur	suant to Minnesota Statutes, sections 3.9224 and 3.9228, and any laws, rules,
or other regula	ations adopted by the relevant Minnesota Tribal government.
