1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human rights; adding vaccination consent to the Human Rights Act;
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 363A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[363A.175] DISCRIMINATION; VACCINATION.**

1.6 It is an unfair discriminatory practice to discriminate against an individual for the
1.7 individual's vaccine status. For the purposes of this section, "vaccine status" is either having
1.8 taken a vaccine to immunize against contagious disease, or not having taken a vaccine to
1.9 immunize against contagious disease.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
