BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **CHAMPLIN; MISSISSIPPI CROSSINGS PARKING AREA.**
- 1.7

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.8

to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
- 1.9

Champlin to design, construct, and equip a parking area, including related site improvements
- 1.10

and infrastructure, for Mississippi Crossings. This appropriation includes money for charging
- 1.11

stations for electric vehicles, an ADA-compliant trail, an event space, an outdoor performance
- 1.12

area, and a municipal dock system.
- 1.13

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.14

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.15

the state in an amount up to \$1,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.16

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.17

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
