1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **EXONERATION AWARDS.**

1.6 The amounts in this section are appropriated in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund

1.7 to the commissioner of management and budget for full payment of awards of damages

1.8 under the Imprisonment and Exoneration Remedies Act, Minnesota Statutes, sections

1.9 611.362 to 611.368. This appropriation is available until June 30, 2023, for payment to:

- 1.10 (1) Bryan Alan Bemboom, \$165,103;
- 1.11 (2) Benjamin Joseph Hill, \$423,212.32; and
- 1.12 (3) Joseph Z. Livingston, \$225,000.
