1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education finance; authorizing a grant for St. Paul Neighborhood
1.3 Network for after-school programming; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; ST. PAUL NEIGHBORHOOD NETWORK
1.6 AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMMING.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Department of Education. The sum indicated in this section is
1.8 appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education in the fiscal year
1.9 designated.

1.10 Subd. 2. St. Paul Neighborhood Network. (a) For a grant to St. Paul Neighborhood
1.11 Network to support and expand its after-school programming options:

1.12 \$ 250,000 2025

1.13 (b) St. Paul Neighborhood Network must work with its Community Technology
1.14 Empowerment Project members, community organizations, and schools to expand its
1.15 after-school programming. To the extent possible, St. Paul Neighborhood Network must
1.16 also seek partners throughout the metropolitan area and in greater Minnesota.

1.17 (c) On January 15th of each year following the fiscal year that St. Paul Neighborhood
1.18 Network receives state aid under this section, St. Paul Neighborhood Network must submit
1.19 a report according to Minnesota Statutes, section 3.195, describing its activities. The report
1.20 must include a link to the organization's most recent federal 990 form, list its participating
1.21 partners, provide demographic information on the number of program participants, and
1.22 summarize participants' outcomes.

- 2.1 (d) Of the amount appropriated in this section, up to five percent is available for grant
- 2.2 administration.
- 2.3 (e) This appropriation does not cancel but is available until June 30, 2027.
- 2.4 (f) This is a onetime appropriation.
