1.8	For the chemical dependency services listed in section 254B.05, subdivision 5, and
1.9	provided on or after July 1, 2015, payment rates shall be increased by ten percent over
1.10	the rates in effect on January 1, 2014, for vendors who meet the requirements of section
1.11	<u>254B.05.</u>
1.12	Sec. 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE; PERFORMANCE MEASURES FOR
1.13	CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY TREATMENT SERVICES.
1.14	The commissioner of human services, in consultation with representatives of health
1.15	plan companies and chemical dependency treatment providers, shall develop performance
1.16	measures to assess the outcomes of chemical dependency treatment services. The
1.17	commissioner shall report these performance measures to the members of the health and
1.18	human services policy and finance committees in the house of representatives and senate
1.19	on or before October 15, 2015.

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
