1.7	Subdivision 1. Agreements valid. (a) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph
1.8	(b), sections 337.01 to 337.05 do not affect the validity of agreements whereby a promisor
1.9	agrees to provide specific insurance coverage for the benefit of others.
1.10	(b) An agreement or contract provision that requires a party to provide insurance
1.11	coverage to another party or a third party for the negligence or intentional acts or omissions
1.12	of another party or third party is against public policy and is void and unenforceable.
