1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. CARVER COUNTY; COUNTY STATE-AID HIGHWAY 18.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	account in the state transportation fund as provided in Minnesota Statutes, section 174.50,
1.9	to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to Carver County for environmental
1.10	analysis, property or permanent easement acquisition, design, engineering, and construction
1.11	of improvements to Carver County State-Aid Highway 18, known as 82nd Street West, and
1.12	associated trails, from Bavaria Road to Trunk Highway 41 in the cities of Victoria, Chaska,
1.13	and Chanhassen. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management
1.14	and budget determines that an amount sufficient has been committed to complete the project,
