BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. <u>REIMBURSEMENT TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES DENIED</u> COVERAGE.

If any participant in the state employees group insurance program was denied dependant coverage pursuant to an audit conducted under Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 10, article 3, section 40, the commissioner of management and budget must prove that a certified letter denying eligibility was delivered to the participant. If the commissioner cannot prove delivery of the certified letter, upon application of a participant whose dependent coverage was reinstated, the commissioner shall reimburse the participant for the cost of other insurance purchased by the participant during the period of denial.
