1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to natural resources; appropriating money for all-terrain vehicle trails.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; VOYAGEUR COUNTRY ATV TRAIL.**

1.5 \$600,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the

1.6 natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources. Of this amount, \$100,000

1.7 is for a grant to St. Louis County for an environmental assessment worksheet for the overall

1.8 construction of the Voyageur Country ATV Trail system and connections and \$500,000 is

1.9 for a grant to St. Louis County to design, plan, permit, acquire right-of-way for, and construct

1.10 Voyageur Country ATV Trail from Buyck to the Holmes Logging Road and to the Shuster

1.11 Road toward Cook.

1.12 Sec. 2. **PROSPECTOR LOOP TRAIL; TACONITE STATE TRAIL.**

1.13 \$2,400,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the

1.14 natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources. Of this amount, \$1,300,000

1.15 is for a grant to Lake County to match other funding sources to develop the Prospector Loop

1.16 Trail system and \$1,100,000 is for a grant to Lake County for design, environmental review,

1.17 permitting, and construction for all-terrain vehicle use on the Taconite State Trail between

1.18 Ely and Tower.
