1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to insurance; prohibiting certain discriminatory cost-sharing policies  
 1.3 for prescription drugs; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,  
 1.4 chapter 62Q.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[62Q.526] PRESCRIPTION DRUG PRICING; PROHIBITION ON**  
 1.7 **HEALTH PLAN IMPOSITION OF HIGHER COST-SHARING FOR CERTAIN**  
 1.8 **DRUGS.**

1.9 No health plan company shall offer, issue, sell, or renew a health plan that imposes  
 1.10 cost-sharing, deductibles, co-payments, or co-insurance on any prescription drug that  
 1.11 exceeds the cost-sharing, deductibles, co-payments, or co-insurance imposed under the  
 1.12 health plan for nonpreferred or nonformulary brand name prescription drugs.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2013, and applies to health  
 1.14 plans offered, issued, sold, or renewed on or after that date.
