1.2 relating to human services; permitting personal care assistance compensation for

1.3 services provided by a parent or spouse; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **PERSONAL CARE ASSISTANCE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES**

1.6 **PROVIDED BY A PARENT OR SPOUSE.**

1.7 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0659, subdivisions 3, paragraph

1.8 (a), clause (1); 11, paragraph (c); and 19, paragraph (b), clause (3), a parent, stepparent, or

1.9 legal guardian of a minor who is a personal care assistance recipient or a spouse of a personal

1.10 care assistance recipient may provide and be paid for providing personal care assistance

1.11 services.

1.12 (b) This section expires upon full implementation and phase-in of the community first

1.13 services and supports program under Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.85.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment, or

1.15 upon federal approval, whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify

1.16 the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

1.17 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; PERSONAL CARE ASSISTANCE COMPENSATION**
