1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 245A.11, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 Subd. 12. Use of resident EBT cards by program staff. For a staff person at a licensed

1.8 residential program to make food purchases on behalf of a program resident using the

1.9 resident's electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card, the staff person must be listed as an

1.10 authorized representative of the resident. A residential program must maintain a log of

1.11 purchases made by program staff using a resident's EBT card and must retain a record of

1.12 purchases made under this subdivision according to section 245A.041.
