1.7	\$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the Board of
1.8	Regents of the University of Minnesota for academic and applied research through the
1.9	MnDRIVE program at the Natural Resources Research Institute to develop and demonstrate
1.10	technologies that enhance the long-term health and management of Minnesota's mineral
1.11	and water resources. Of this amount, \$600,000 is to support demonstration of three sulfate
1.12	reduction technologies for improved water quality and \$1,400,000 is for continued
1.13	characterization of Minnesota iron resources and for developing next-generation technologies
1.14	and iron products. This research must be conducted in consultation with the Minerals
1.15	Coordinating Committee established under Minnesota Statutes, section 93.0015. This is a
1.16	onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2023.
