624.714, subdivision 18. 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 624.714, subdivision 18, is amended to read: 1.6 Subd. 18. Employers; public colleges and universities. (a) An employer, whether 17 public or private, may establish policies that restrict the carry or possession of firearms by 1.8 its employees while acting in the course and scope of employment. Employment related 1.9 civil sanctions may be invoked for a violation. 1.10 (b) A public postsecondary institution regulated under chapter 136F or 137 may establish 1.11 policies that restrict the carry or possession of firearms by its students while on the 1.12 institution's property. Academic sanctions may be invoked for a violation. 1.13 (c) A public postsecondary institution regulated under chapter 136F or 137 may establish 1.14 policies that restrict the carry or possession of firearms by visitors while on the institution's 1.15 property.
