- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 152.01, subdivision 18, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 18. **Drug paraphernalia.** (a) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b), "drug
- 1.7 paraphernalia" means all equipment, products, and materials of any kind, except those items
- 1.8 used in conjunction with permitted uses of controlled substances under this chapter or the
- 1.9 Uniform Controlled Substances Act, which are knowingly or intentionally used primarily
- 1.10 in (1) manufacturing a controlled substance, (2) injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise
- 1.11 introducing into the human body a controlled substance, ~~(3) testing the strength, effectiveness,~~
- 1.12 ~~or purity of a controlled substance,~~ or ~~(4)~~ (3) enhancing the effect of a controlled substance.
- 1.13 (b) "Drug paraphernalia" does not include the possession, manufacture, delivery, or sale
- 1.14 of hypodermic needles or syringes in accordance with section 151.40, subdivision 2.
