[169.8665] SPECIAL SOYBEAN MEAL-HAULING VEHICLE PERMIT. 1.5 Subdivision 1. Special three-unit vehicle permit. The commissioner may issue a permit 1.6 for a vehicle that transports soybean meal and meets the following requirements: 1.7 (1) is a combination of vehicles, including a truck-tractor and a semitrailer drawing one 18 additional semitrailer, and no semitrailer used in the three-vehicle combination has an overall 1.9 length in excess of 28-1/2 feet; 1.10 (2) does not exceed a maximum gross vehicle weight of 106,000 pounds; and 1.11 (3) is operated only in this state on marked U.S. Highway 75 in Crookston to marked 1.12 U.S. Highway 2, and on marked U.S. Highway 2 from Crookston to the North Dakota 1.13 border. 1.14 Subd. 2. **Special two-unit vehicle permit.** The commissioner may issue a permit for a 1.15 vehicle that transports soybean meal and meets the following requirements: 1.16 (1) is a combination of vehicles consisting of a truck-tractor and a single semitrailer that 1.17 may exceed 48 feet, but not 53 feet, if the distance from the kingpin to the centerline of the 1.18 rear axle group of the semitrailer does not exceed 43 feet; 1.19 (2) does not exceed a maximum gross vehicle weight of 106,000 pounds; and 1.20
