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Sec. 5. AGENCY HEAD SALARY FREEZE.

Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 15A.0815, subdivisions 1 and 5, the incumbent of a position listed in Minnesota Statutes, section 15A.0815, subdivisions 2 and 3, may not receive an annual salary in excess of the amount that the incumbent of the position received in the previous fiscal year.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

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Sections 1 to 4 are effective the day following final enactment. Section 5 is effective the day following final enactment and applies to salaries listed under Minnesota Statutes, section 15A.0815, subdivisions 2 and 3, between January 1, 2015, and June 30, 2015. The restriction provided under section 5 applies to current incumbents and any successors.
