1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to campaign finance; allowing collection of private contact information

1.3 for candidates, treasurers, and chairs for specified purposes; amending Minnesota

1.4 Statutes 2020, section 10A.14, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 10A.14, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 2a. **Alternate contact information; form.** (a) A candidate; treasurer of a political

1.9 committee, political fund, principal campaign committee, or party unit; or chair of a political

1.10 committee, principal campaign committee, or party unit may file a form with the board that

1.11 includes alternate contact information. If a form is filed, the form must include the following

1.12 information for the filer:

1.13 (1) name;

1.14 (2) political committee, political fund, principal campaign committee, or party unit; and

1.15 (3) alternate contact information.

1.16 (b) The board must only use the alternate contact information to contact the filer for the

1.17 purposes of administering this chapter. Information collected pursuant to this subdivision

1.18 is private data on individuals.

1.19 (c) For purposes of this subdivision, "alternate contact information" means an address,

1.20 telephone number, or e-mail address that is different from the information provided on the

1.21 form required by subdivision 2.

1.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2021.
