

S.F. No. 212, as introduced - 87th Legislative Session (2011-2012) [11-1283]

2.1 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Minnesota calls for a unifying symbol
2.2 recognizing this nation's solemn debt to the estimated 1.6 million fallen members of our nation's
2.3 armed forces throughout history and the families and communities who mourn their loss; NOW,
2.4 THEREFORE,

2.5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota that the Honor and
2.6 Remember Flag is designated the State of Minnesota's emblem of service and sacrifice by the
2.7 brave men and women of the United States armed forces who have given their lives in the line of
2.8 duty.

2.9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Minnesota urges
2.10 Congress to pass a House Resolution to designate the Honor and Remember Flag for the same
2.11 purpose.

2.12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota is
2.13 directed to prepare copies of this memorial and transmit them to the President of the United States,
2.14 the President and the Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and the Clerk of the
2.15 United States House of Representatives, the chair of the Senate Committee on Veterans, the chair
2.16 of the House Committee on Veterans, and Minnesota's Senators and Representatives in Congress.
