- 1.10 obtained the required license or permit. Rental of or permission to use a public facility is
- 1.11 not a commercial transaction for the purposes of this chapter. In the event that an on-sale
- 1.12 or off-sale license has been issued and the state is unable to issue a permit, the license shall
- 1.13 be deemed sufficient to allow purchase until the state is able to issue the necessary permit.
