1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission for grants to local governments under
1.9	Minnesota Statutes, section 240A.09, paragraph (b), to improve indoor air quality and
1.10	eliminate R-22. This appropriation shall not be used to acquire ice resurfacing or edging
1.11	equipment. The commission may prioritize grants to projects in environmental justice areas
1.12	of concern. For the purposes of this subdivision, "environmental justice area of concern"
1.13	means one or more census blocks in Minnesota:
