1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to finance; extending availability of fire remediation grants; amending  
 1.3 Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 1, article 4, section 31.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 1, article 4, section 31, is amended  
 1.6 to read:

1.7 **Sec. 31. APPROPRIATION; FIRE REMEDIATION GRANTS.**

1.8 \$1,392,258 is appropriated in fiscal year 2018 from the general fund to the commissioner  
 1.9 of public safety for grants to remediate the effects of fires in the city of Melrose on September  
 1.10 8, 2016. The commissioner must allocate the grants as follows:

1.11 (1) \$1,296,458 to the city of Melrose; and

1.12 (2) \$95,800 to Stearns County.

1.13 A grant recipient must use the money appropriated under this section for remediation  
 1.14 costs, including disaster recovery, infrastructure, reimbursement for emergency personnel  
 1.15 costs, reimbursement for equipment costs, and reimbursements for property tax abatements,  
 1.16 incurred by public or private entities as a result of the fires. This is a onetime appropriation  
 1.17 and is available until June 30, ~~2018~~ 2021.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
