1.2relating to public safety; appropriating money for grants to law enforcement for

1.3portable recording systems.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **PORTABLE RECORDING SYSTEMS; APPROPRIATION.**

1.6\$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the Peace Officer

1.7Standards and Training Board to provide grants to local law enforcement agencies for

1.8portable recording systems. The executive director shall award grants to local law

1.9enforcement agencies for the purchase, maintenance, and support of portable recording

1.10systems and portable recording system data. An applicant must provide a 50 percent match

1.11to be eligible to receive a grant. The executive director must give priority to law enforcement

1.12agencies located outside of the seven-county metropolitan area that do not have a portable

1.13recording system program. Of this amount, up to 3.5 percent is for administration and

1.14monitoring of the program. This appropriation is available until June 30, 2025.
