1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to public safety; creating reimbursement grants for audits of the physical

1.3 security of public school campuses.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **PHYSICAL SECURITY AUDIT GRANTS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**

1.6 \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of public safety for grants to public school districts to reimburse applicants for up to 100

1.8 percent of the cost for an audit of the physical security of public school campuses and crisis

1.9 management policies adopted pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 121A.035, subdivision

1.10 2. The commissioner shall establish specific eligibility and application criteria including a

1.11 requirement that audits be conducted by consultants holding professional certification

1.12 deemed acceptable by the commissioner, including but not limited to a Certified Protection

1.13 Professional certification from the American Society for Industrial Security. The base for

1.14 fiscal year 2021 is zero.
