1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. [168.1258] MINNESOTA AGRICULTURE SPECIAL PLATES.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Issuance of plates. The commissioner must issue Minnesota agriculture
1.8	special plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:
1.9	(1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
1.10	truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;
1.11	(2) pays an additional fee in the amount specified for special plates under section 168.12,
1.12	subdivision 5;
1.13	(3) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
1.14	(4) pays the fees required under this chapter;
1.15	(5) contributes a minimum of \$20 annually to the Minnesota agriculture account; and
1.16	(6) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
1.17	licensing of drivers.
1.18	Subd. 2. Design. In consultation with the commissioner of agriculture, the commissioner
1.19	must adopt a suitable plate design that includes a depiction of lands and activity related to
1.20	agriculture.

2.2	fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor vehicle
