BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. TODD COUNTY; TRANSFER STATION.

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,600,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to Todd County under the solid waste capital assistance grant program under Minnesota Statutes, section 115A.54, to predesign, design, construct, and equip a new solid waste transfer station, to renovate the existing transfer station into a regional single-stream materials recovery facility, and to build and expand the regional source-separated organic material composting facility.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$6,600,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
