| Section 1. NATIONAL LOON CENTER IN THE CITY OF CROSSLAKE. |
| Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$7,900,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fur |
| to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Crosslake for site |
| preparation and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a new building and |
| adjacent outdoor public space improvements, including surface lot parking areas, in the c |
| of Crosslake to house a national loon center, to provide visitor, education, and exhibit |
| facilities for the general public, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695. This |
| appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determine |
| that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by |
| Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502. |
| Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond |
| proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds |
| the state in an amount up to \$7,900,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effe |
| prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota |
| Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. |
